Make-Up Policy

If a student is absent the day before an exam or quiz, the student is expected to take the exam or quiz within 2 days upon return.

However, lab is also a place in the classroom which needs to be safe. All students will need to sign a lab safety contract at the beginning of the school year. Grades

Grades will be based on the 90/10 percentages as described in the district's policies. The grade scale is below:
